Commemorating the 650th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Ravidas Ji

The Be-gumpura Dialogue, commemorating the 650th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Ravidas Ji, is being organised under the leadership of the British Ravidassia Heritage Foundation (BRHF), in collaboration with the Advanced Study Institute of Asia (ASIA) and Network for Access to Justice and Multidisciplinary Outreach Foundation. The event is conceived as a global community initiative led by an international organising committee comprising eminent Ravidassia community leaders, scholars, professionals, and representatives from India and the global diaspora.

Be-gumpura and the Governance Paradigm: Documenting Twelve Years of Inclusive Nation-Building

A landmark commemorative publication is proposed to be released as the centrepiece of the **Be-gumpura Dialogue**, documenting the convergence between the timeless philosophy of **Shri Guru Ravidas Ji** and the transformative governance vision of **Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi ji** over the past twelve years. The publication will chronicle how Guru Ravidas Ji's ideals of equality, dignity of labour, social justice, inclusion, ethical public conduct, and empowerment of the marginalised find contemporary expression through key governance initiatives and public policy. Conceived as a scholarly yet accessible reference, the publication will serve as the foundation for deliberations during the international conference and will be **formally released at the National Dialogue and Community Leadership Conclave in New Delhi**. Thereafter, it will be presented and deliberated upon at the subsequent commemorative programmes proposed in the **United Kingdom** and **Brussels**, and disseminated through the **British Ravidassia Heritage Foundation's network of more than two dozen National chapters globally**, reaching the global Ravidassia diaspora to foster dialogue on value-based governance, social inclusion, and nation-building inspired by the enduring vision of **Be-gumpura**.

Lead Organisation

The British Ravidassia Heritage Foundation (BRHF) is an internationally recognised diaspora organisation dedicated to preserving and promoting the spiritual, cultural, and social legacy of Shri Guru Ravidas Ji. An International Organising Committee comprising representatives of BRHF's global chapters, religious institutions, scholars, community organisations, professionals, entrepreneurs, and youth leaders is being constituted to oversee planning, outreach, and execution of the commemorative programmes. The committee will work in close coordination with Advanced Study Institute of Asia (ASIA) and Network for Access to Justice and Multidisciplinary Outreach Foundation, which will provide institutional support in research, documentation, policy engagement, programme management, publications, and stakeholder coordination.

Global Commemorative Series (2026–27)

The Be-gumpura Dialogue is envisioned not as a standalone event but as a global commemorative movement celebrating the 650th Birth Anniversary of Shri Guru Ravidas Ji. The proposed commemorative calendar includes:

November 2026 — New Delhi, India

National Dialogue and Community Leadership Conclave

Bringing together over 1,200 delegates, including representatives from more than 350 Shri Guru Ravidas Ji Gurudwaras and Temples across the world, alongside eminent religious leaders, scholars, policymakers, entrepreneurs, professionals, youth representatives, and members of the global Ravidassia diaspora.

United Kingdom

Global Ravidassia Diaspora Convention

Proposed to be held at the House of Lords, UK Parliament.

January 2027 — Brussels, Belgium

European Community & Policy Dialogue

Proposed to be held inside the main chamber of the European Parliament.

Together, these events will connect community leadership from India and the global diaspora, creating a sustained international platform to celebrate the philosophy of Be-gumpura, promote social harmony, strengthen community engagement, and reinforce the enduring message of equality, dignity, fraternity, and inclusive nation-building envisioned by Shri Guru Ravidas Ji.
